A UNIQUE EXPERIENCE, IN A UNIQUE DESTINATION

The Manuels River Hibernia Interpretation Centre is situated on the banks of Manuels River - one of the oldest river systems in North America.

Just 24 km from downtown St. John's, this internationally-recognized geological site is known for its 500-million-year-old trilobite fossils. It is protected and preserved by the Manuels River Natural Heritage Society, whose mandate is the preservation and protection of the natural, cultural, and geological history of the area.

A world-class facility, the Manuels River Hibernia Interpretation Centre offers educational programming, guided geological tours, audio tours, and exhibits. It is a versatile venue that hosts a variety of functions, including business meetings, weddings, concert performances, receptions, and corporate functions. Full catering and bar service are available.

The Centre includes a café, gift shop, full suite of audio/visual technology, and 52-seat movie theatre. Seven kilometres of river-side walking trails reveal picnic areas, protected fossil sites, and scenic river valleys. The trail also connects with the newly developed T'Railway.

The Centre also hosts a wide variety of events throughout the year including specially themed Science Camps, and holiday events such as Easter Egg Hunts, Haunted Hikes, and a New Year's Ball.
